## T r e v i t h i c k ' s I n v e n t i o n

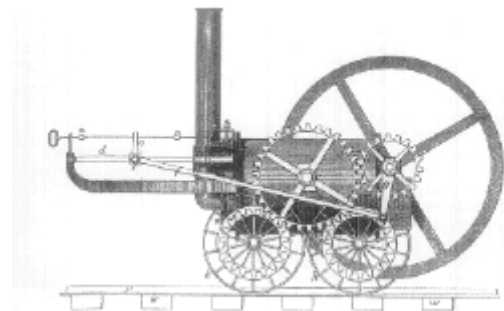
